

# Convert a foreign license to a Swedish license

## - Procedures

- Swedish resident living in Sweden must hold a Swedish licence.
- Foreign resident living in Sweden more than 12 months needs to convert the license to a Swedish license, see below.
- Foreign resident who jump in Sweden but live abroad more than 6 months may use their foreign license, with the exception of becoming SFF instructor.

### When converting a foreign licence, the following routine applies:

Requirements for a Swedish license are a completed and approved medical examination, the latest updated available on the website to be used. [www.sff.se>fakta för hoppare>läkarundersökning](http://www.sff.se/fakta-för-hoppare/läkarundersökning)

1. Send approved medical examination (MEDICINSK TJÄNSTBARHETSBEDÖMNING) to SFF's office:

2. Become a member of a Swedish club. With the club membership, you also get a membership in SFF
3. Email personal data to the Register office, [info@sff.se](mailto:info@sff.se) that creates a SkyNet profile and assigns license numbers.
4. Contact the Chief Instructor (CI) in your selected club. CI verifies:
  - *Logbook*
  - *The license*
  - *Emergency procedures*
  - *If necessary, oral/written exam*
  - *If necessary, AFF or skill jumps*
  - *When applying for B license or higher, ensures that the required knowledge for packing certificate is noted in SkyNet. SFF rigger approves.*
5. Apply for a license in SkyNet. CI approves, the SFF Register Office approves.

**Please note that all skydivers must have knowledge of and comply with the Swedish Parachute Association's Regulations Parachute Operations (SBF), Chapter 402.**
