Purpose

To crown Nordic Champions in Canopy Piloting, improve knowledge of, and competences in Canopy Piloting as well as developing and disseminating information about skydiving in general in Denmark and the Nordic countries. The competition also aims to exchange experiences and strengthen friendships between skydivers around the Danish and Nordic skydiving clubs.

Competition schedule

13th-17th of July

Training and registration

Registration no later than the 17th of July at 19.00 o'clock.

18-20th of July

Competition starts at 9am if weather permits

The competition will be held between sunrise and sunset if required due to weather constraints.

Takeoff for the last competition load will be no later than 16.00 o'clock on the 20th. of July

The award ceremony takes place as soon as possible after the last round of all disciplines and classes has been completed, has been judged and the protest period of two (2) hours has expired.

Registration

For now, registration is done by attending the Facebook Event. An official invitation will be shared in upcoming bulletins.

Payment

Entry fee will be DKK 500,-. The money will be added to your Dropzone Burble account to be used for the competition jumps.

In case the competition does not complete at least four rounds, the money is non-refundable and will be used by the club to cover expenses related to running the competition.

Jump price is DKK 150,-

Rejumps are paid by the competitor.

Competition classes

All classes shall do 9 jumps to complete the competition

Aircraft

Two Cessna 182s or larger.

Protest fee

300 DKK, which is refunded if the protest is approved.

Food and beverages

On competition days, 3 meals per day are available for purchase at the club.

During the training period, beverages are available for purchase at the club and the kitchen in the club is to be used free of charge.

Accommodation

A bunkhouse is available at the club, however, the rooms are reserved for competition officials as required. Toilets and showers are available throughout training and competition free of charge. A campsite is available at the dropzone. Power at the campsite is accessible for the price of 50 DKK for the complete week.

Disclaimer

The distance course is 185 m long, thus not approved for FAI world records.

Gear requirements

The rig in use must be approved for jumping at the competition dates according to the organizational rules in the country of the jumper.

An AAD is required to be installed and active under all jumps, unless an allowance to jump without an AAD has been acquired from DFU for the specific competition or the complete season by writing to iu@dfu.dk.
