

# Procedures for conversion from foreign license to Swedish license

- Swedish national resident in Sweden must hold a Swedish licence.
- Foreign national resident in Sweden for more than 12 months shall convert their foreign licence to a Swedish licence as below.
- Foreign nationals who skip season in Sweden but live abroad half the year can continue to jump on a foreign license, with the exception of wanting to train as an instructor within SFF.

## **When converting a foreign licence, the following routine applies:**

1. Requirements for a Swedish license are a completed and approved medical examination, the latest updated on SFF:s webpage: <https://www.sff.se/index.php/fakta-for-hoppare/lakarundersokning-2>
2. Send the medical examination to Svenska Fallskärmsförbundet, Pontus Widéns väg 18, 722 23 VÄSTERÅS or to e-mail: [info@sff.se](mailto:info@sff.se)
3. Become a member of the Swedish club and through them you get membership of SFF
4. Email personal data to the Registry, [info@sff.se](mailto:info@sff.se) that creates a SkyNet profile and assigns license numbers.
5. Contact CI in the selected club that goes through:

*-Log - book*

*-If necessary, theoretical repetition and reserve-pull procedure*

*-If necessary, for new skydivers- AFF or skills jumps, For instructors-*

*-when applying for license grade B or higher ensures that the required packing knowledge is available for the package in SkyNet. Approved controller delegated the task and approves.*

5. Apply for a license in SkyNet. CI approves, the Office approves.

**Please note that all persons engaged in sports skydiving must be aware of and comply with the Swedish Parachute Association's Regulations Parachute Operations, SBF Chapter 402:**
