

# Converting a foreign license to a Swedish license

## - Procedures

- Swedish resident living in Sweden must hold a Swedish licence.
- Foreign resident living in Sweden for more than 12 months, needs to convert the license to a Swedish license, see below.
- Foreign resident who jump in Sweden but live abroad more than 6 months, may use a foreign license, except for becoming an SFF instructor.

### **When converting a foreign license, the following routine applies:**

1. Requirements for a Swedish license are a completed and an approved medical examination, **available on the website to be used.** <https://sff.se/medlemmar/for-hoppare-piloter/medicinsk-tjanstbarhetsbedomning/>
2. The medical posted to SFF's office, Pontus Widéns väg 18 722 23 VÄSTERÅS
3. Become a member of a Swedish club and with that membership, you get your membership to the SFF
4. Email personal data to the Register office, [info@sff.se](mailto:info@sff.se) - a profile in SkyNet is created and license numbers assigned.
5. Contact Chief Instructor in the selected club. CI will verify:

*-Log – book*

*-If necessary, theoretical repetition and knowledge of emergency procedure*

*-If necessary, AFF or skill jumps*

*-when applying for B license or higher, ensures that the required knowledge for a packing certificate is noted in SkyNet. SFF rigger approves.*

5. Apply for a license in SkyNet. CI approves, the SFF Register Office approves.

**Please note that all skydivers must have knowledge of and comply with the Swedish Parachute Association's Regulations Parachute Operations ([SBF](#)), Chapter 402**
