SWEDISH AVIATION SPORTS FEDERATION in collaboration with SWEDISH PARACHUTE ASSOCIATION and PARACHUTE CLUB CIRRUS GOTHENBURG invites you to the closed Swedish Championships and open Nordic Championships in Wingsuit Performance.

Purpose

To crown Swedish and Nordic Champions in Wingsuit Performance, set Swedish records in Wingsuit Performance, and to develop and disseminate information about skydiving in Sweden and the Nordic region. The competition also aims to exchange experiences and strengthen the friendship between skydivers from skydiving clubs across Sweden and the Nordic region.

Competition Conditions for Swedish Championships

Regulated in SBF 1.3.4

The conditions for competing in a Swedish championship competition, and being able to receive the RF (Riksidrottsförbundet) championship badge, require membership in a Swedish club affiliated to SFF.

Competition Discipline

Wingsuit Performance Open

Wingsuit Acro Open

The Swedish Championships in Wingsuit Performance category is a closed competition.

For a competition to take place, at least three teams/competitors from two different clubs must be registered. The competition organization reserves the right not to hold a competition in a discipline if only one team/competitor is registered or if teams/competitors from only one club are registered.

RF (Riksidrottsförbundet) Badges and Medals

RF badges are awarded in accordance with RF's statutes Chapter 12, Section 2, to the categories Open. Swedish Championship medals are awarded in accordance with General Competition Rules Chapter 2, Section 2.2.3 to all categories and classes.

Nordic medals are awarded in accordance with FSF's General Competition Rules Chapter 2, Section 2.2.3 to all categories and classes.

Registration

Preliminary registration must be received by the competition organization no later than June 13, 2025. Official registration and registration fee (1500 SEK) must be received by the competition organization no later than June 14, 2025.

The competition organization reserves the right to close registration earlier if the number of participants/teams exceeds the number of competition slots. The competition organization reserves the right to cancel the entire competition if too few teams/competitors are registered and the finances do not add up. Late registration, after June 14, 2025, will be accepted subject to availability and a fee of 500 SEK per team/individual competitor.

The registration fee must be received by the competition organization no later than June 14, 2025.
The registration fee is non-refundable and goes towards the expenses of the competition.

Competition Fee

Wingsuit Performance Open

Exit altitude: as per regulations

Official training day: Sunday 13 of July , 10:00-18:00

Any re-jumps are paid for by the competitor.

Training jumps are purchased separately.

Competition fees are to be paid at the manifest at Parachute Club Cirrus Gothenburg (FKCG) before the competition begins.

Wingsuit Performance Open

Rounds: 9 (minimum 1 round to crown a champion in the sub-discipline; if there are no winners in all sub-disciplines, no overall winner is crowned)

Discipline fee for 9 rounds: 4050 SEK (450 SEK/jump)

Wingsuit Acro Open

Rounds: 7 (Minimum 1)

Discipline Team fee for 7 rounds: 9450 SEK (450 SEK/jump)

Aircraft

Pac750XL. Takes a maximum of 16 jumpers to 4000m in approximately 17 minutes. The competition management may decide to use another aircraft.

Competition Schedule

Check-in day and Meeting Sunday 13 of July

Check-in All day at the DZ and with the Judges later that day

Team leader briefing at 20:00

Competition days: Monday - Thursday, 14 - 17 of July

Competition starts at 08:00–20:00

Competition ends at 18:00 17 of July

The competition management may advance or postpone the competition depending on weather conditions.

Last lifts depart no later than 19:00 on Thursday, 17th of July.

The prize giving ceremony will take place in Vårgårda with a banquet as the conclusion at 19:00.

Doping

RF's doping regulations apply. Doping tests may be conducted. Dispensations for medications listed on RF's doping lists (<http://www.rf.se/Antidoping/Dopinglistor>) must be applied for individually. Alcohol is prohibited according to FAI's rules.

Competing for Another Club (applies to Swedish Championships)

Competitors can compete for a club other than where they are a member. Application for this is done via the form ""Ansökan om att tävla för en annan klubb"" (Application to compete for another club) on SFF's website. SFF TK (Competition Committee) is the decision-maker regarding club changes. This applies to all competitors, including reserves. Applications can be made no later than at the check-in for the competition. You can find the conditions in the Competition Rules Chapter 1, 3.1 Conditions for participating in the competition.

Protest Fee

500 SEK, refunded if the protest is upheld. If the protest is rejected, the fee goes to SFF's competition fund.

Food and Refreshments
